SERVANTS SUMMER VOLUNTEER CAMPS

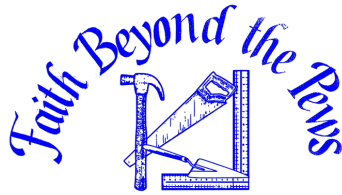
You want to make a real difference—one that brings lasting hope and healing.

Volunteer camps are a fantastic opportunity for anybody to serve — retirees, youth groups, small groups, and families... even businesses looking to engage the community! We truly believe that anyone can serve — regardless of age, race, gender, religion, disability, or skill level! We work hard to match volunteers with projects where they will feel comfortable and provide skilled team leaders to guide them. **It is our job to make serving easy for you!**



FLEXIBLE SCHEDULE

Volunteer camps are flexible — you can serve for the entire week or select the days/times that best fit your schedule! Meals are provided each day of camp — breakfast and dinner are served at the host site, and bagged lunches are packed in the morning and taken along to the work site. You are welcome to serve as an individual volunteer, or with a participating group (youth group, small group, business etc)

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How much does it cost?

Servants does not charge people to participate in our work camps. However, we are a non-profit and rely on donations to offset our costs. The average cost for construction materials is \$1000 per project. We also incur costs for food and drinks during the volunteer camp week. A suggested donation of \$75 per participant would be greatly appreciated.

Should I bring my own tools?

Servants will provide all required tools and materials and oversee each project. Bringing your own hand tools (hammer, tape measure, square, etc.) may be helpful. If you bring any personal tools, please mark them with your name.

What should I wear?

We require closed-toed shoes or boots, knee-length shorts or jeans, and modest tops. You will be performing construction type work and should dress appropriately for safety.

Where do we sleep?

Servants does not provide overnight accommodations during volunteer camps. Most volunteers travel to their own homes each night. If you or your group are traveling from out-of-town, you are responsible for securing overnight accommodations.

How do I get to the work site?

You are responsible for providing transportation to and from the work site each day. It may be possible to carpool with other members of your team.

Is there an age restriction for volunteers?

We do not have any age restrictions; however, we do have some guidelines for children and youth who are serving. For youth groups, we request a ratio of 1 leader for every 5 youth. We also welcome youth and children under the age of 14, but ask that they serve directly alongside a parent, guardian, or youth leader.

OTHER WAYS TO SUPPORT SERVANTS WORK CAMPS

Unable to volunteer for some reason? Here are 4 other ways that you or your church/organization can support Servants:

1 **Pray for our staff, volunteers, and the homeowners we will be serving**

Pray for safety for the volunteers and staff. Pray that lives will be transformed as God's love is shared and relationship are built throughout the week!

2 **Prepare and serve a meal for volunteers during a volunteer camp**

Organize a small group that will prepare a breakfast or dinner meal for our volunteers. Each host location has a kitchen on site along with a kitchen coordinator. Please contact workcamps@servants.org if you are interested in providing a meal for a volunteer camp.

3 **Conduct a supply drive at your church or business**

Collect items for our volunteers and homeowners to use during the volunteer camps. See the sidebar for specific items that we need!

4 **Donate money or gift cards towards our food and material costs**

Monetary donations are always appreciated! Online donations are accepted at www.servants.org/giving. We can also use gift cards to Giant or Weis for food supplies, along with Home Depot or Lowe's gift cards for building materials.
